
Welcome to your local newsletter, which tells you what's happening on ACHA's Mid Argyll estates. Coming up in the next few months...

Winter works

During the winter season, our grounds maintenance team are making good use of their quiet season to work on our sheltered schemes at **Caledonia Court, Lochgair Place & Chalmers Court**. They will be removing moss from paths and doing a winter tidy-up.

External wall insulation

Work is going well in Tarbert, Lochgilphead & Adrishaig to make our homes warmer and more attractive with external wall insulation. ACHA have also managed to pull in external funding for the works, saving money and getting more value for our tenants' rents. The contractors are on site in all areas and aim to be finished by Spring 2024.



Architects progressing funding bid for Duncholgan TP site

In September, Inch Architects met with our Duncholgan residents and members of the wider Traveller Community to progress plans for applying for Scottish government funding. The architects are currently getting costings for potential improvements to the Duncholgan Travelling Persons site, and we are hoping to apply for funds when the next round of funding opens.

Estate walkabouts 2023 - what we found



Blocked gutters - ordered to be cleared. Roughcast jointly owned with private owner - we negotiate to get the repair done, and get it fixed if it's affecting our tenants.



Overgrown brambles or hidden gardens that need more care - we contact the tenants and keep on at them until the garden is clear.



Rain!





Discarded items that need uplifting - we keep up the contact with our tenants to get them to do the right thing and clear their things. If they don't do it themselves, we uplift it and recharge them for the cost.



Flytipping on ACHA land - where we can't find the owners, we arrange for it to be uplifted.



Weed trees in walls - quickly cleared by ACHA's ground maintenance team.
